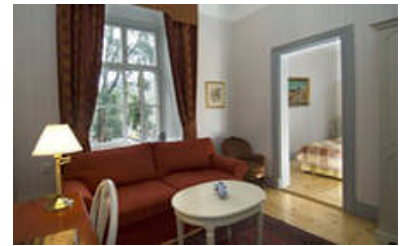
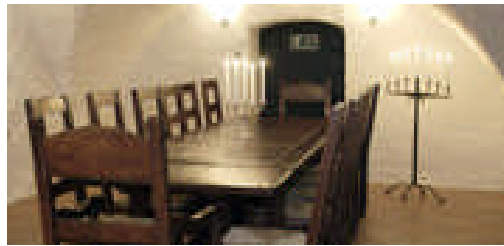
Park Avenue Hotel 9th to 11th July

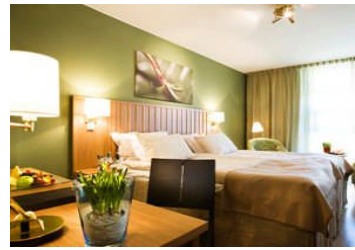
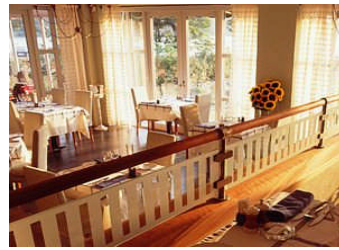
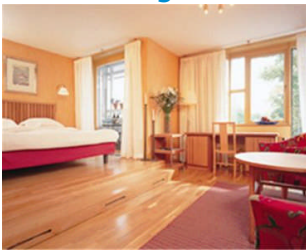
Nordic Sea Hotel ****

Villa Källhagen ****



Located just 5 mins walk from some of Stockholm's major tourist attractions, including the Vasa Museum, Skansen and the Djurgården ferry all on the island of Djurgården. This hotel looks out over the Djurgården Kanal (part of Stockholm harbour) and is in the leafy central area of Östermalm.
